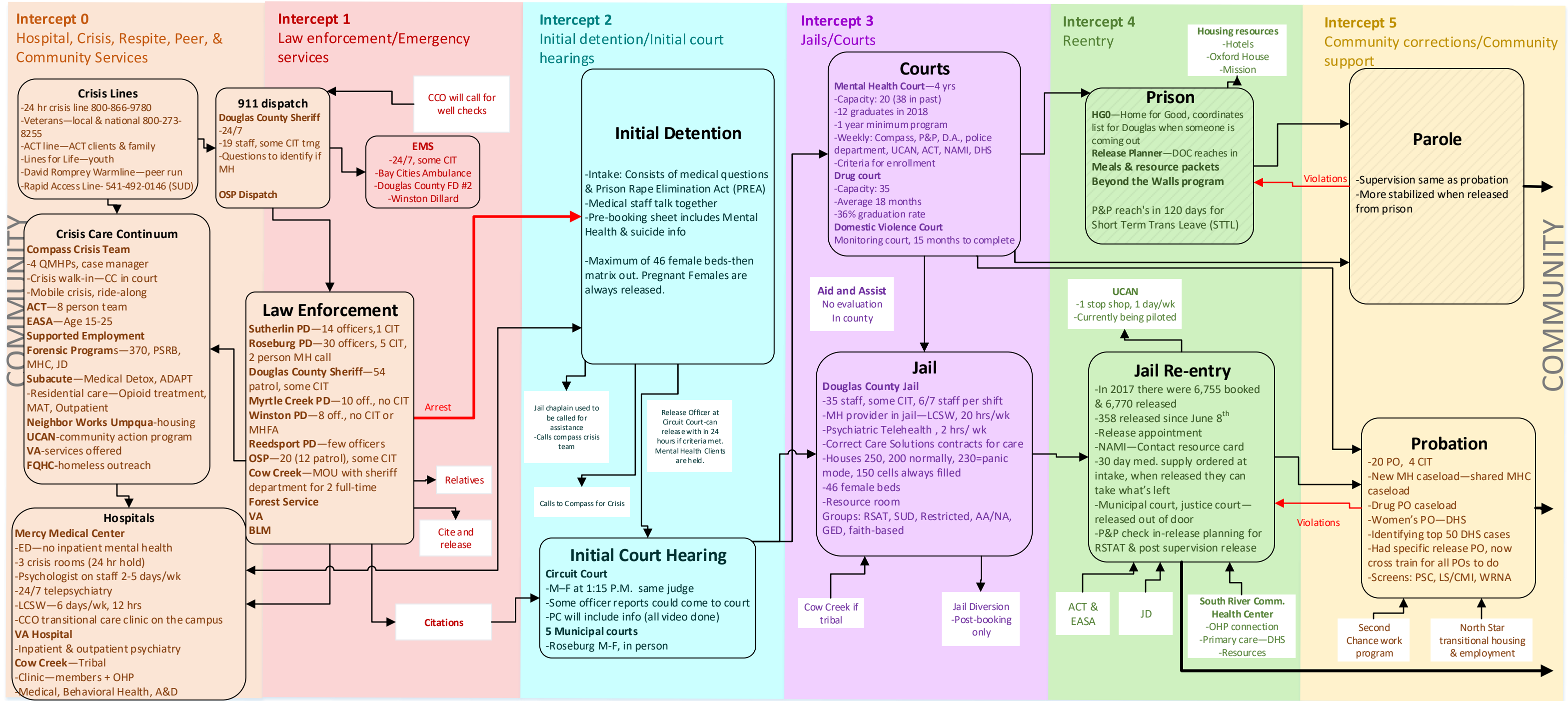


SEQUENTIAL INTERCEPT MAP: DOUGLAS COUNTY
